BEGINNING OF THE JOURNEY:



Shabdkruti Foundation, incorporated under Section 8 of the Companies Act, began its journey by rehabilitating needy and homeless women in Chaparala.

Following this, the foundation undertook various projects funded by its directors and individual donors, including distributing ration kits during the COVID-19 pandemic, providing financial assistance to needy professionals during the pandemic, and empowering women through workshops in Wani, Zari, and Maregaon to help them become entrepreneurs. Additionally, we distributed blankets to people sleeping on the streets during winter. Shabdkruti Foundation has now begun to focus on the development of tribal communities and the health sector in association with the Chaitanyam Institute for Human Excellence in Healthcare.


